Pledge for More 900 Ambassadors, 2,500 Members and 6,000 Volunteers across the World to Support the United Nations' Efforts against COVID-19

I humbly wish to, most respectfully introduce to His Excellency, the Global Youth Climate Action Initiative (Climate Action Group, as it is famously known), a Non-governmental global organization with primary focus on climate action and sustainable development. The Organization engages in raising awareness on climate change, advocacy and youth mobilization & empowerment for climate action and sustainable development. We work as a network of individual volunteers, as well as, partner and supporter group. 6. Provision of platform for the establishment of Environmental Clubs with the name "Climate Action Group" in selected primary and secondary schools in Nigeria, with a view to catching the children young and instill environment concern into the psyche.
7. Organization of environmental waste recycling youth empowerment programme in Bauchi State, Nigeria, for 120 members tagged #ClimateAction and #CAGBauchi in 2019-2020.
